Minutes

01/Welcome and Introductions

01.01 Alex Belkofer welcomed the attendees to the bi-annual meeting. The Executive Officers: Heather Cassady, Adrienne Sraver, and Dave Stanton introduced themselves.

02/Mission, Vision and Values of the IAC

02.01 Alex Belkofer, Heather Cassady, Adrienne Sraver, Dave Stanton, and Holly McLean shared their perspectives on the value of the Council. Their comments included our Initiatives, Networking with students and staff, Women INspire events, marketing, diversity, and the student experience.

03/Membership Task Force

03.01 Larry Walden stated we have 18 new members. He provided an overview of the membership process where 2 recommendations from the IAC members are needed for a prospective new member.

03.02 The motion to approve Dave Brown with Dave Brown Consulting, LLC. as a new member was presented, moved on and approved in the meeting.

04/Financial Update

04.01 Dave Stanton shared a detailed overview of the budget. He described the difference between the Donations fund and Scholarship fund.

04.02 Dave outlined the allocations of incoming funds to the CSM Competitions Teams, support for Committees, Scholarships, and Industry/Student Mixers. He shared the importance of collecting the annual membership donations. Blank membership dues forms were handed out for the Council members to fill in and return.

04.03 Parker Brown shared Scholarship opportunities and how the IAC member Companies can advertise throughout the year.

05/AY 2016-17 Board Initiatives Update

05.01 Alex Belkofer gave a brief overview of the Initiatives and introduced the members presenting updates.

05.02 **Advancing Women in Construction** – Holly McLean shared our partnership with Dr. Gonul Kaletunc's mentoring program Aspiration for Women's Advancement and Retention in Engineering and Science (AWARES). Three of our members were mentors this past year. The program is looking for more mentors for next Fall. Adrienne Sraver shared that the IAC plans to hold another Women INspire Construction event in the Fall to continue promoting the goal for advancing women in construction. Heather Cassady mentioned the National Association of Women in Construction (NAWIC) WIC week event

Holly McLean was 1 of 4 panelists for this luncheon. 05.03 **Assisting with Department Staffing/instruction needs** - Dr. Shearer provided an update for the Department of FABE Program/CSM staffing. The new Dean of College of Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences, Dr. Cathann Kress, started today. LaShanda Coleman is an Academic Adviser for CSM/ASM. Jordan Clark has been hired for Professor of Professional Practice. Chip Tuson started today as the Communications Program Manager. Rachel Cornell is the Fiscal Officer. Jenna Eaves is teaching the 30 Hour OSHA course. Andrea Pruneau is teaching Professional Development. Ben Vause is teaching Estimating and Scheduling.

05.04 Dr. Shearer stated the future staffing concerns includes surveying courses. 05.05 Dr. Shearer stated FABE picked up 70 students for a total of 675; CSM current enrollment is approx. 300 students.

05.06 Alignment of Curriculum with National and Local Organizations and Entities - Alex Belkofer shared his experience at the ACCE Mid-Year Meeting held in February. He discussed a handout on Key Takeaways for Development. Alex mentioned an IAC workshop that will be scheduled with the FABE faculty to discuss these takeaways. 05.07 - Increasing Diversity in the CSM Program – Alison Marker and Deborah Lisheid discussed the Diversity Committee goals. The Committee is focused on recruiting women and minorities and marketing the CSM program. A few items they are working on include: targeting undecided majors, creating a marketing video, recording testimonials, Women Inspire event, expansion of Dr. Kaletunc's mentorship program, and partnering with organizations such as the BX for outreach.

05.08 - **Collaboration with National and Local Industry Associations –** Alex Belkofer mentioned the CSM Club Roundtable that included ABC, AGC, BX, and BIA. He discussed the next steps included partnering more with these organizations.

05.09 – Mac Ware provided an update on the 4 NewB Competition teams. They received 1st and 3rd in Commercial and 2nd in Heavy/Civil and Residential.

05.10 – Ben Vause gave an overview of the NAHB Student Competition. He plans to take a team this coming year. The competition project will be posted in September and the students present on the project in January in Orlando.

06/Committee Reports & Updates

06.01 – **Industry Interaction** - Marc Ribe reported on how the committee is raising funds for the competition teams and industry events for the students. They will be working on fundraising, interaction with the CSM Club for industry speakers, and planning the Networking events.
