Why do I have both an academic advisor and a faculty advisor?

All FABE pre-major students are assigned to an academic advisor. Once students are admitted to the major, they will additionally have a dedicated faculty advisor within their specialization to guide them throughout the program. Each role serves different functions and has different expertise.

Academic Advisor (assigned to pre-FABE and FABE majors)

- Assists with class scheduling
- Provides expertise on degree requirements
- Collaborates with you to create timeline to graduation
- Provides assistance for academic difficulties
- Informs you about university resources
- Oversees graduation processes

Faculty Advisor (assigned to FABE majors)

- Provides expertise in your specialization
- Helps with selection of technical elective courses
- Gives guidance on course substitutions within the major
- Connects you to research opportunities
- Discusses opportunities that align with your career goals
- Guides you on planning related to graduate or professional school
